## U.DANCE NATIONAL FESTIVAL 2024

Each year in July, the U.Dance National Festival takes place in a new host city. The National Festival has previously been held at the **Southbank Centre** in **London**, **Dance City** in **Newcastle** and **DanceEast** in **Ipswich**.

This **3-day festival** celebrates the vibrancy and talent of youth dance from across the four nations. With activities ranging from national dance showcases to careers talks, dance workshops, as well as choreographic activity and performances.

In August each year, we also host a special **U.Dance on Screen** showcase featuring incredible youth dance films from around the UK. Previously, we have hosted U.Dance on Screen at the **BFI Southbank, London**.

# U.DANCE: LOCAL, REGIONAL & NATIONAL

Across the year One Dance UK works with partners to deliver the UK's largest youth dance platform, *U.Dance*. This national programme of events offers high quality dance opportunities to young people at local, regional and national level.

## U.DANCE Regional

Each spring, regional platforms are hosted by a network of partner organisations, showcasing the talents of the region's young dancers. These platforms offer exciting performance and workshop opportunities to thousands of young dancers. Successful groups are selected to take part in the National Festival.

## U.DANCE National Festival

Every summer, One Dance UK presents the *U.Dance National Festival*, a 3-day celebration of youth dance. Young dancers from across the region perform on the biggest stages, take part in workshops with leading dance professionals and are offered inspiring dance careers information.

**The U.Dance National Festival is held in a new host city every summer, spotlighting dance happening in the region whilst also celebrating youth talent from all areas of the UK.**

**14%** of educators in higher educational settings offer 7 or more hours of extra-curricular dance.\* Access to dance education remains a 'postcode lottery', depending on where a young person lives and which school they go to.

**53%** of educators surveyed in our recent HE Report felt that the negative perception of the value of the arts and associated career paths in the media and from the Government has contributed to the decline of dance in HE, influencing parents and carers to guide students into choosing a 'more valuable' degree.\*\*

The *U.Dance* platform empowers young people to express their artistic talent and make informed choices about their own career trajectories. The National Festival provides talks with HE providers, dance workshops, career sessions and aspirational talks with leading industry professionals from across the sector.

# ACCESS SPONSORSHIP

- Remove barriers such as finance and support aspiring young people to take part in an established, life-changing programme motivated to promote dance as a sustainable and valued career pathway
- Enable accessible and inclusive routes into dance
- Support costs that can present a barrier to participation including transport, accommodation, and food.

Sponsorship benefits offered are the same across both levels. Increased sponsorship deepens reach, impact and level of access support offered to young participants during *U.Dance National Festival*.
